Did you know that in the EU...

- ✓ 2 % of the presidents of the largest companies are women
- √ 63% of Members of the European Parliament are men
- ✓ There are 4 men for every woman who gets news coverage
- ✓ Women earn an average of 16 % less than men, and the pension gap is as high as 39%
- ✓ Women are 4 times more likely than men to work part-time.
- ✓ An estimated 1 in 3 women has been a victim of male violence, 1 in 5 of rape
- ✓ Women cannot access legal abortion in 4 EU member states






Why a European Women's Lobby?






2016: Challenges ahead

Attacks on civil society space




2016: Opportunities!
