EPF Research into Anti-SHRH Opposition

- 490 anti-choice organisations identified in 32 European Countries
- Main findings:
- 1) 3 types / 'families' of anti-choice
- 2) Not well organised at European level but increasingly inter-connected
- 3) Anti-choice movements appear to be a **reactive response** to social/legal changes (ie. they are not pro-active)

2. ECPM : European Christian Political Movement





- Initiative of 2 Dutch political parties in 2002
- CU obtains funding from Dutch Ministry for Foreign Affairs for democracy/human rights work in East Europe (MATRA Project)
- ECPM opens offices in Timisoara, Romania – Leo van Doesburg since 2009 – travels around East Europe

- 19 political parties in 15 countries member of ECPM
- ECPYM (Youth) and ECPF (Foundation) created
- 2010 : Gains official recognition by EP as a new political family
- eligible for core funding of €200-400K /year from EP

4. Closer look at EPP – European Peoples' Party

- Largest political family in Europe
- Most EPP parties indifferent/ uncomfortable with SRHR
- Many lean negatively towards SRHR (ES, IT, PL, IE, etc...)
- Some, openly progressive (F, SE, BE, etc....)

A minority EPP parties are aggressively antichoice and seek to leverage the whole of the EPP....
