Did you know that in the EU...

- 2 % of the presidents of the largest companies are women
- 63% of Members of the European Parliament are men
- There are 4 men for every woman who gets news coverage
- Women earn an average of 16 % less than men, and the pension gap is as high as 39%
- Women are 4 times more likely than men to work part-time
- An estimated 1 in 3 women has been a victim of male violence, 1 in 5 of rape
- Women cannot access legal abortion in 4 EU member states








Why a European Women's Lobby?




EWL'S VISION




2016: Challenges ahead

Illusion of equality, or interest just for economic growth

- Impact of the crisis and austerity measures on women and on women's organisations (funding)
- Weakening/disappearance of institutional mechanisms for gender equality and women's rights
- Climate of conservatism and anti-feminism, anti-gender movements, backlash against women's rights, especially Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights
- Impact of neoliberalism & consumer society on women's representations, roles and stereotypes: commodification, sexualisation, dividing the movement
