Reasonable
blow job but just a bad
attitude and making no effort to
look interested or even pretend to
enjoy. I cut it short after ten minutes
and asked for a refund. She gave me

back £50 of the £150 I gave her. I decided that was wrong for just ten ninutes and took back £130. I thought £20 was more than she even deserved for her poor performance. She had a bit of a rant and slammed the door behind me. Very unusual for a Thai girl.

Impact on society: the commodification of women's body

Sex buyers have a more degrading representation of women and of the relationships between women and men

'She gave up her rights when she accepted my money'

For 27% of men, the concept or 'rape' is ridiculous for women in prostitution

Half of sex buyers continue the transaction even after clear signals that the woman is under 18





More than 200 NGOs agree on:

Four principles:

- ✓ Prostitution is a form of violence
- ✓ Prostitution is a form of exploitation of inequalities
- ✓ Prostitution is a violation of human dignity
- ✓ Prostitution is a violation of human rights





BRUSSELS' CALL

'TOGETHER FOR A EUROPE FREE FROM PROSTITUTION'

Six recommendations:

- ✓ The suppression of repressive measures against prostituted persons;
- ✓ The criminalisation of all forms of procuring;
- ✓ The development of real alternatives and exit programmes for those in prostitution;
- ✓ The prohibition of the purchase of a sexual act;
- ✓ The implementation of policies of prevention and education, to promote equality and positive sexuality;
- ✓ The development of prevention policies in the countries of origin of prostituted persons.

Europe towards abolition

- ✓ 17 out of 27 EU member States have ratified the **UN Convention** of 1949 for the Suppression of the Traffic in Persons and of the Exploitation of the Prostitution of Others.
- ✓ Council of Europe Parliamentary Assembly Resolution "Prostitution, trafficking and modern slavery in Europe", 8 April 2014



✓ European Parliament resolution "Prostitution, sexual exploitation and its impact on gender equality", 26 February 2014:

"One way of combating the trafficking of women and under-age females for sexual exploitation and improving gender equality is the model implemented in Sweden, Iceland and Norway (the so-called Nordic model), and currently under consideration in several European countries, where the purchase of sexual services constitutes the criminal act, not the services of the prostituted persons".

✓ European Parliament resolution on an EU Strategy on equality between women and men, May 2015:

"Calls on the Commission and the Member States to explore the reasons why women resort to prostitution and ways to discourage demand; underlines the importance of programmes for exiting from prostitution".



Regulation in Europe: Spain

- ✓ Regional/city competence
- √ 300 000 women in prostitution (pop. 50 millions)
- Brazil, Eastern Europe, China
- √ 39% of men are buyers (after Porto Rico and Thailand)
- Negative impact on young people (self-esteem and sexuality)
- Prostitution schools
- ✓ The sex industry makes 18 billion euros of benefit each year
- ✓ Impact of the crisis





Turn Off the Red Light End Prostitution and Sex Trafficking in Ireland

- ✓ Sexual Offences Bill adopted on 14 February One Billion Rising!
- Removes offense of soliciting
- Criminalises sex buyers
